### **NOTICE OF EVALUATION AND SCORING OF PROJECT APPLICATIONS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that St. Johns County Housing and Community Development Division, in conjunction with the Affordable Housing Grant Review Committee, will be hosting an evaluation and scoring of project applications from community agencies for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). The scoring and evaluations will occur on June 30th, 2017, from 10 AM to 12 PM in the Egret Conference Room within the Health and Human Services Building located at 200 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, FL 32084. The Committee's recommendations shall be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for approval on August 1, 2017.

The County is not obligated to award all funds available during a particular grant cycle. The County reserves the right to reject any and all applications submitted on the basis that the proposed projects do not meet one of the CDBG National Objectives, are in conflict with the rules and regulations of the CDBG program, are incomplete, or are not submitted prior to the submission deadline. Project proposals shall provide for projects consistent with the St. Johns County 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awards an annual grant to St. Johns County to carry out a wide range of community development activities directed toward revitalizing neighborhoods, economic development, and providing improved community facilities and services. Through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, individual communities, with public input, develop their own projects and funding priorities, based on CDBG National Objectives. Communities are required to give maximum priority to activities that benefit persons of low-income and moderate-income. Activities may also aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight, or meet other community development needs having a particular urgency. The County provides a portion of its CDBG funds, on a competitive basis, to eligible community agencies for specific activities that meet one or more of the CDBG National Objectives.
