Starting Pay \$11.81 an hour (Incentive for EMT's & Paramedic's)

- Must be at least 18 years and have a valid Drivers License
- Be able to swim 500 meters in under 10:00 minutes, Run ½ mile in under 3:30 minutes

No Experience Needed: All required training provided at no cost during the Marine Rescue Academy

- CPR for healthcare provider (American Heart Association)
- Emergency Medical Responder Certification
- Advanced Open Water Lifeguard Certification (USLA)
