

St. Johns County Marine Rescue New Hire Checklist

Please use the checklist to ensure that you follow all of the steps required to complete training with St. Johns County Marine Rescue and be eligible for consideration as being hired as a seasonal lifeguard.

Step 1: Complete Initial Paperwork - Initial paperwork is due at the time of your tryout. You will not be allowed to participate in the tryout if any of your paperwork is missing or incomplete.

	Must be 18 years old by the completion of the Marine Rescue Academy (see dates below)
	Complete entire form including initialing page one.
	Attach a copy of your driver's license and social security card. Alternative forms of identification including birth certificates or passports will not be accepted.

Training Waiver

	Complete the form.
	Have the form notarized by an authorized notary (Forms can be notarized at the time of the tryout by Lt. J. Earl if you provide proper id)

Physician Physical Form

	Complete a physical at any doctor's office, you must use the St. Johns County Physical form
	Fill out your portion of the form including signing and dating.
	Have the doctor's office complete their portion of the form including signing, dating, and stamping

Step 2: Attend Tryout - All potential new guards are required to physical skills assessment in order to qualify to attend the Marine Rescue Academy. Skills assessment consist in – 500 meter swim in under 10:00 minutes, ½ mile run in under 3:30. All tryouts will take place at Solomon Calhoun Pool 1500 Duval Street, St. Augustine Florida 32084

Step 3: Attend Marine Rescue Academy – All new guards are required to attend the Marine Rescue Academy in its entirety in order to work for St. Johns County Marine Rescue as a seasonal lifeguard. The MRA consist of 8 hours of CPR for healthcare provider, 40 hours of Emergency Medical Responder and 40 hours of Advanced Surf Rescue. The MRA academy is provided free of cost.
