Attaching Files in Adobe Reader:

1. Click on Comment on the right hand sidebar.
2. Under Annotations, select the paperclip icon. Cursor will change to a push pin.
3. Click on the pdf where you want the file attachment icon.
4. An Add Attachment window will open. Navigate to the file that you want to attach and click OPEN.
5. Select any file attachment properties (optional) and click OK.
6. Your file attachment icon will display on the pdf. Select icon to move to desired location.
