

Upon motion by Commissioner Lovett, seconded by Commissioner Parrish and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Inspectors and Clerks of an election within the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 25, in St. Johns County, Florida, to determine whether or not a special tax district, to be known as Vilano Beach Street Lighting District, within the following described area, to-wit:

Commence on Atlantic Ocean at Township line between Section 32, TWP 6S, Range 30 E and Section 5, TWP 7S, Range 30 E; thence Westerly along said Township line to run of Intracoastal Waterway; thence Southerly along run of Intracoastal Waterway and North River to a point which is City limits of St. Augustine extended; thence Westerly to City limits; thence Southerly along City limits line to intersect with Vilano Beach Bridge causeway; thence Westerly and Northerly to City limits line; thence Southerly along City limits line to West of Matanzas River; thence Southeasterly to Vilano Beach point; thence Easterly to Atlantic Ocean; thence Northerly along Atlantic Ocean to point of beginning.

held on November 5, 1968, having made a return of the results of said election, and said return having been canvassed by the Board of County Commissioners, as provided by 67-850, General Laws of Florida, 1967.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, does hereby declare the result of said election to be as follows:

That 76 ballots were cast in the affirmative, and 14 ballots in the negative within the above described area, lying within Voting Precinct No. 25, on the question of whether a special tax district, to be known as Vilano Beach Street Lighting District, should be created.

2. That a majority of votes cast within said area were in favor of creation of said special tax district.

3. That this Board does hereby enter an order creating a special tax district within the above described area, to be known as Vilano Beach Street Lighting District.

4. That a certified copy of this resolution be furnished by the Clerk of this Court to the Governor of the State of Florida, the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, the Comptroller of the State of Florida, and the Tax Assessor of St. Johns County, Florida.
