Affordable Housing Advisory Committee St. Johns County, Florida Regular Meeting

August 16, 2023 Minutes

The Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) of St. Johns County met at 3:00 pm at the Health & Human Services Center in the Muscovy Conference room at 200 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, Florida 32084.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Chair, Alex Mansur.

Notices regarding the meeting were sent to all members. No press was in attendance.

- 1. <u>Introduction of AHAC Members and SJC Staff</u>: Committee members and County staff were acknowledged and a quorum was present.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Motion made by Roy Alaimo to approve minutes of the July, 2023, meeting; motion seconded by Harry Maxwell. The motion passed unanimously.

- 3. <u>Administrators' Report</u>: Joe Cone reported that Victoria Crossing was open for leasing and St. Johns County was pleased to announce that there will be an office occupied by a Social Services staff member within the leasing office on property. As reported last month, there were some complaints by residents at San Marcos Heights but as of now, all issues have been resolved and everything is going well. Mr. Cone announced that there will be two guest speakers at the September meeting, Billy Zeits, Corner Lot Development, and Tom Ingram, Esq., SODL & Ingram PLLC. Both speakers will be discussing affordable housing developments. Michael O'Donnell asked if there will be a ribbon cutting ceremony at Victoria Crossing. Mr. Cone confirmed that one is planned and he stated that all Committee members will be notified when a date and time is set.
- 4. <u>Annual Report/Senate Bill 102:</u> Harry Maxwell started the discussion about the annual report and stated that in his view, the annual report only requires a few changes. Alex Mansur suggested that there be language added to define affordable housing and Amy Ring stated she would work with other County staff members, as well as the Committee, to determine the best definition, which will then be added to the beginning of the annual report. The Committee agreed to list the incentives in order of importance, identifying the actionable items within each. It was determined that the top three incentives are flexible densities, modification of impact fees, and public land inventory. Alex Mansur asked that staff send out a copy of last year's report, and he then requested Committee members review and bring any changes, additions, or deletions to next month's meeting.
- 5. <u>Public Comment</u>: Lisa Franklin, Alpha Omega Miracle Home, asked if any consideration had been given to reducing or eliminating impact fees for non-profits. Ms. Franklin suggested a waiver and Mr. Cone stated he would look into the matter. Mr. Maxwell asked that he also be provided any information Mr. Cone shares with Ms. Franklin with regard to impact fees.
