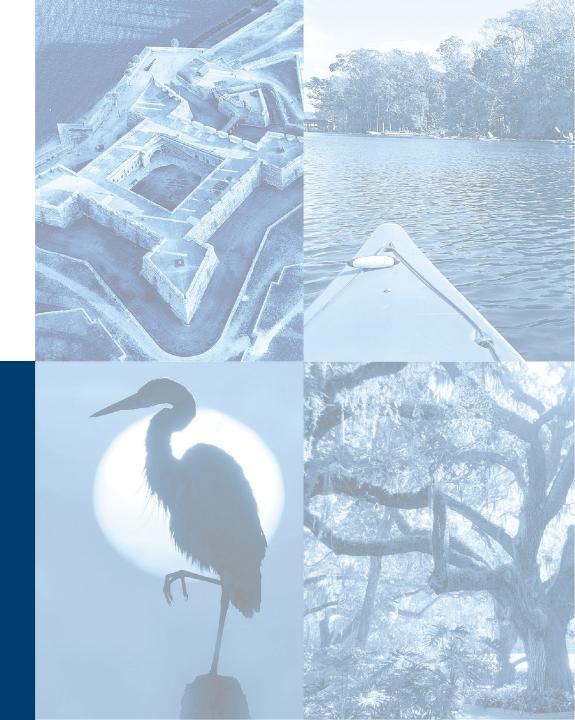


Economic Development & Incentives

- Attract new and existing business development, expand and diversify the tax base, and create new high-wage jobs for St. Johns County residents.
- Enhance the County's economic development branding and marketing efforts to reach new geographic regions and targeted industries.
- Cooperatively partner with the SJC Chamber of Commerce, other governments, and other agencies (JAXUSA, UNF SBDC, etc.) as appropriate to attract, secure, and retain business development within the County.







UF Health St. Johns

In 2023, Flagler Health+ became part of the University of Florida's academic health center and was renamed UF Health St. Johns. This impactful change will improve the health of the region by combining innovative health care opportunities with a longstanding legacy of supporting the community.



The development of an Economic Development Strategic Master Plan specific to St. Johns County began, which will create the foundation for the department's future economic development efforts.


New Brand Launch
