



# FY23 & 24 Accomplishments

#### **Administration**

• Launched SJC Connect mobile application

#### Fleet Management

- Implemented the Vehicle Condition Index (VCI)
- Implemented the Automated Vehicle Locator (AVL) system

#### **Engineering**

- Over \$20 million in pavement management projects to improve over 100 miles of County roads.
- Managed over 60+ Transportation Capital Improvement Projects totaling in excess of \$250 million.

#### **Current Solid Waste Contracts**

Contracts for residential household garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection with Republic Services and Waste Management.

Expire July 31, 2024

Disposal contract for the operation and maintenance of both transfer stations and disposal of all garbage with Waste Management expires in 2029.


#### **Weekly Curbside Collection**






