

**ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2024-\_\_\_\_\_**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDER RESCINDING ST. JOHNS  
COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2024-8, WHICH  
ORDERED A MANDATORY EVACUATION OF CERTAIN  
PORTIONS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY  
(HURRICANE MILTON)**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the state of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 24-214 & 215, declaring a State of Emergency in certain Florida counties including St. Johns County pertaining to Hurricane Milton; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County Emergency Order 2024-6 declared a state of local emergency within St. Johns County pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4 because of the severe threat posed by Hurricane Milton to St. Johns County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the emergency powers granted pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance 2021-4, the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners issued Emergency Order 2024-8, instating a mandatory evacuation of certain portions of St. Johns County; and


**WHEREAS**, Emergency Order 2024-8 remains in effect until rescinded; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County Emergency Management has determined that there is no longer a need to continue the mandatory evacuation established by Emergency Order 2024-8 and that Emergency Order 2024-8 should be rescinded.


**NOW THEREFORE**, in accordance with the emergency power vested in the St. Johns County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2021-4, St. Johns County Emergency Order 2024-8 is hereby rescinded.
