In accordance with Section 125.66 (3), Florida Statutes, the County hereby publishes the following information:

AN ORDINANCE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2022-37 REGULATING ST. JOHNS COUNTY UTILITIES, THIS ORDINANCE SPECIFICALLY AMENDS SUBSECTION A, SECTION 17 (WASTEWATER DISCHARGE LIMITS AND PROHIBITIONS) ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2022-37 TO PROVIDE FOR DELEGATION OF PRETEATMENT AUTHORITY AND SUBSECTION B, SECTION 18 (INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER DISCAHRGE PERMITTING) ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 2022-37 TO PROVIDE A TIMEFRAME FOR REVIEWING DATA AND PRETREATMENT PERMIT APPROVAL OR DENIAL; MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; ADDRESSING BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE REQUIRED BY SECTION 125.66, FLORIDA STATUTES; **PROVIDING FOR APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENERS ERRORS; PROVIDING** FOR AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance amends Utility Ordinance 2022-37 to clarify the delegation of authority from the Utility Director to the Pretreatment Coordinator and provides for a timeline for reviewing data and issuing or denying pretreatment permits. These are suggestions from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. This amendment serves the public health, safety, and morals and welfare of the County. 2.
